JOB OPPORTUNITY – LANDS AND RESOURCES DIRECTOR

Under the direction of the Director of Operations, the Attawapiskat First Nation (AFN) is recruiting for the position of Lands and Resources Director. The Lands and Resources Director is to advise, and coordinate any items affecting the traditional lands of the Attawapiskat First Nation with Leadership and the membership.

Summary of Duties:

- Investigate, REVIEW, and recommend strategic priorities for the AFN respecting lands and resource management in AFN respecting lands and resource management in AFN traditional territories.
- Liaise with AFN Council, AFN members, other First Nation, government and corporate officials concerned with lands and resources management and activities.
- Assess the relevant provincial and federal regulatory requirements for permitting, mitigation and monitoring required at all stages of proposed developments, and assist the AFN to intervene where required in regulatory processes
- Develop plain-language summaries explaining to AFN members the technical aspects and potential effects of existing or proposed developments.
- Develop and maintain a database of research and land use planning information
- Develop strategic communications process related to lands and resource activities
- Develop and implement an organizational plan for the Lands and Resources Office
- Lead and coordinate a team of staff and consultants in researching, monitoring and reporting on existing and proposed resource developments in regards to socio-environmental impacts that are taking, or planned to occur in AFN traditional lands
- Prepare proposals for funding to support training and research activities
- To coordinate and oversee implementation of any environmental agreements the First Nation enters into.

Summary of Qualifications:

- College graduate in relevant field, or combination of work experience in a relevant field
- Must be able to effectively communicate with members of the public, and fellow staff members in the English, and Cree language
- Must have two years of managerial, or supervisory experience
- Must be able to work flexible hours
- Must be able to complete written reports
- Must have valid Ontario drivers License
- Ability to communicate in the Cree language an asset (oral and/or written)
